NOTICE OF RACE

28-31 August 2023

Clube Naval Charitas, Niterói, Brazil

Organizing Authority: Clube Naval Charitas and Associação Brasileira da Classe Dingue

1. RULES

1. The event will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.
2. RRS Appendixes P and T will apply.
3. In all rules governing this event. (a) **(DP)** denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the International Jury; and (b) **(NP)** denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING (DP, NP)

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ENTRY REGULATIONS

1. Only current, fully paid members of a Dingue Class National Association (if it exists) and of a World Sailing member national authority may enter the event.
2. No resale or transfer of entries is allowed.
3. Each sailor shall have a World Sailing Sailor ID, which is required to enter the event. A World Sailing Sailor ID can be obtained free of charge by registering online at: <https://www.sailing.org/sailors/world-sailing-profile/>
4. Categories:

Youth	Helmsman aged until 16 years old.
Master	Helmsman aged between 45 and 55 years old.
Grand Master	Helmsman aged 46 years old or older.
Female	All Female sailors
Mixed	One Male and one Female Sailor
1.5	Total Crew Weight greater than 150Kg

4. APPLICATION & ENTRY

1. Entry will be accepted on the website (<https://velaviagem.com.br>)
2. The Application closing date is 27 August 2023, 17:00. (UTC-3)



3. The Entry fee is U\$S 50 If Application form is filled and payment recived by the organization until 31 July 2023. After this date, entry fee will be 80 U\$S.
4. The Application Form contains all the necessary information for payment of the Entry fee.

5. BOATS AND EQUIPMENT (NP, DP)

1. All competitors shall use only one hull, sail, batten set, mast, boom, centre board and rudder; all of which shall be identified during equipment inspection.
2. In the event of damage, boats and equipment may only be substituted with the written permission of the Technical Committee in accordance with the sailing instructions.
3. When ashore boats shall be kept in their assigned places at the venue.
4. Boats may be required to display identification numbers supplied by the organizing authority.
5. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the organizing authority.
6. Access to the boat park may be restricted during certain hours including the hours of darkness.

1. 8 Races are scheduled with a maximum of three races per day.
2. Succeeding races will be started as soon as practicable after the finish of the previous race.
3. On the last day of the championship, no warning signal will be made after 16:00.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available from the website before the entry closing date.

8. RACE OFFICE

The Race Office is located at Clube Naval Charitas, in front off the optimist bearths.

9. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION (NP, DP)

Equipment inspections may be made throughout the event at the discretion of the class representative, race committee or the jury.

10. COACH REGISTRATION & TEAM/COACH/SUPPORT BOATS (NP, DP)

1. All coach/support boats shall pre-register online at the event website (<https://velaviagem.com.br>) until 28 August 2023.



2. All coach/support boat drivers shall confirm registration of their boats and submit the names and sails numbers of the sailors they are supporting at the race office before 18:00 on 22 August 2023.
3. Each coach/support boat shall clearly display an identification numbered flag supplied at registration. No other individual support boats shall be used.
4. Each coach/support boat is required to carry a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving all international ship-to-ship channels.
5. The Organizing Authority recommends that all Coach/support boat drivers and crews wear a personal flotation devices securely fastened at all times when afloat except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.
6. When the coach/support boat engine is running, coach/support boat drivers shall be connected to a device that will stop the engine if the boat driver falls out the boat or is otherwise not in control of the boat.
7. The movements of coach/support boats will be restricted as defined in the sailing instructions.

11. COURSES

1. Windward-leeward courses – Will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.
2. The target time for the first boat in each race will be 45 minutes.

13. BOATS COMMUNICATION (DP)

Except in an emergency, when racing a boat shall neither make voice, or data communication not available to all boats.

14. SAFETY (DP)

Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device at all times when afloat except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.

15. SCORING

1. Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
2. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

16. TITLES & PRIZES

The first 5 overall and the first 2 in each category will be awarded. If there is only 1 sailor in a category, the sailor will be reallocated to other category by the RC.

17. PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

By entering the event competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the event and/or using the event facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitors name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

18. LIABILITY

1. The Clube Naval Charitas, the Associação Brasileira da Classe Dingue and all their officers, members and volunteers do not accept liability for loss of life or property, or personal injury or damage caused by or arising out of the event. Competitors take part in the event at their own risk.
2. The establishment of the notice of race and the sailing instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat he is sailing.
3. All competitors shall maintain their boats in a safe and seaworthy condition.



4. A competitor shall be of good health and a competent sailor capable of racing an ILCA in open water in all conditions including strong winds.
5. At-fault occurrences to other boats are the responsibility of the helmsman. Competitors are not covered by any liability insurance provided by the organizing authority and should provide their own coverage for personal goods and liability protection. The organizing authority recommends that competitors consult their own insurance carriers to assure they are covered at this event and regarding additional personal liability insurance coverage.
6. A competitor is recommended to have personal accident and health insurance that covers him while attending the event and while racing.

19. INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by law, each competitor agrees to indemnify and hold the Clube Naval Charitas, owners, affiliates, officers, employees, agents, committee persons and race officials acting in their official capacities harmless, from any third party claim to the extent arising from a competitor's, or related support person, acts or omissions.

20. CHANGES TO THE NOTICE OF RACE

This notice of race may be subject to amendments which will be identified on the event website.
